Dr. Carley:

Welcome to “What’s Ailing America” – This will be the last edition of “What’s Ailing America”, at least on RBN. I’ll be discussing that at the end of the show. Today’s show is going to be “What’s Ailing America: Trauma at Birth”. Pat Jordan will be calling in, as well as my 2 guests: Rich Winkel, who has been on the show before talking about circumcision, as well as Janel Martin who has an outstanding DVD targeted at fathers to help them protect their children when they’re born, which is called “The Other Side of the Glass”. So I’ll be bringing on those individuals on shortly.

I do want to mention that starting the 1st Monday in February, I will be doing a weekly conference call where people can ask questions about vaccinations. Patrick Jordan: I’m here Dr. Carley. Let me just say Hello Dr. Carley, hello listeners. Thank you all for just a terrific time out here on RBN. This is the last time that Pat Jordan is coming to you from the grain ghetto in Illinois. I’ve been searching for the primal trauma that allowed this

entire race to be taken over, and the answer was brought to us on a wave of a body of knowledge that allowed us to harmonize everything that we've worked on so far into the big picture.

Dr. Carley:

We're back, Patrick continue, don't forget to mention your web-site. I highly suggest to those who haven't already done so to obtain the 3 books that he has written which you can access on his web-site, www.vaccinefraud.com

Patrick Jordon:

Thank you Dr. Carley. I just want to let all the listeners know that we'll still be available through our normal channels, my web-site www.vaccinefraud.com and my e-mail is generalportal55@gmail.com. You and I, Dr. Carley, have always been talking about the big picture, and I was actually surprised to find that the primal traumas that allowed human beings to be conditioned and mind-control slaves. The primal one wasn't religion and blaming people for killing God. It wasn't Santa Claus blaming you for being bad. Circumcision and birth trauma, in my understanding, my estimation, my research into this problem, is the single thing that has to be overcome for anyone left standing on this demon planet, that claim it and then remake it in their own image. Folks, we've done all that we can to bring you this information – The job is now up to you.

Now with respect to different birthing methods, I just wanted to put out my opinion, which of course, I always invite free rebuttal on. Water births, to me seem extremely irresponsible, dangerous and probably a plot of the admiralty. Think about it folks. Water birth. Born of water. The claim made by the admiralty to enslave all the children on the planet is that they were born of water, therefore they can rule over them because they rule the sea. To give birth in a natural body of water, a pool or a tub guarantees exposure of the baby and the open bloodstream of the mother to every parasite, bacteria, fungus, virus and chemical in the natural water source or the city water supply. In my estimation there's nothing wrong with an open-air land birth.

But folks, here's the shocker: Here's the thing you really have to come to terms with that I did myself and I'm just passing it on to you. My final assessment of this entire situation is to stop breeding. Children are the money and energy system for evil. If we stop it at the root, this insanity can't continue. That's my final message, Dr. Carley.

Dr. Carley:

OK, well one thing I will say is that of course giving birth in the hospital is going to expose you to every super bug, parasite and things of that nature you can imagine and so that's the worst place to give birth. As far as not having children anymore, certainly if I knew what I know now when I was having my son, I would not have had my son. However, people want to have children and I understand that, but definitely in my opinion, this is not a real good time to do so because with everything that's happening, it's going to get really ugly.

So, on that note, let me bring on my first guest, Janel Martin; she has done a DVD which you can access on the internet, “The Other Side of the Glass”, which is the first information that’s been done for fathers as far as protecting their wife and child, as the child is born, and this was totally brought home to me in terms of the importance. My chiropractor recently had his second child and he called me after the child was born in the hospital because unfortunately his wife had to have a C-Section, and although he’s totally anti-vaccine, he had already made arrangements with the MD that was supposed to be at the birth because the child was not supposed to be given a vitamin K shot because the Vitamin K shot is also toxic; and there’s a black box warning on it, has never been tested to see if it causes cancer, etc. etc.

There were other things that he was not going to allow the child to be subjected to. However, all the doctor had to say to him was, “The state mandates that we give the vitamin K shot”, and he totally succumbed. As far as he knows the child was not vaccinated, but of course, the child was put in the NICU (Neo-Natal ICU) right after birth because of the fact that the child allegedly had been exposed to beta hemoletic strep by the mother, so we have no idea what happened to the child in the NICU, or whether they vaccinated the child. This is what’s going on. It’s just amazing to me, and I’m sure you heard this before Janel as well, that all they have to do is just threaten CPS in some form or another, to the parent. IF you don’t do what we say, we’re going to take your baby away from you.” And that’s a very common way that they get parents to go along with whatever they want. So, Welcome to the show Janel.

Janel Mirendah:

Thank you for having me here. I just wanted to say that my last name is Martin-Mirendah.

Dr. Carley:

I’m sorry for that mistake.

Janel Mirendah: T

That’s ok, I just wanted to clarify that.

Dr. Carley:

OK. Let me just mention two things and then I want you to tell people how they can access your DVD. As I was watching, you have a version that’s about an hour and 15 minutes or so, that I watched, and I understand that when the final production is completed it will be about 4 hours, and I can’t wait to see that. At one minute, 22 seconds there was a dad on explaining the boy-child being circumcised without any anesthesia, and how they use a string tightened on the foreskin in order to accomplish this, and that he had never heard such a scream. It just gave me the chills, imagining the torture of this child. When I was a surgery resident, in the first year, we did do circumcisions, and in those cases, the circumcisions were always done under anesthesia, but that’s really irrelevant because of course when the baby wakes up, he’s going to be in extreme pain anyway.

Janel Mirendah:

And they are removing vital tissue that he has the right to have, and has the right to make the choice.

Dr. Carley:

Of course. And another very amazing sound bite came at 51 minutes and 14 seconds. An RN by the name of Brook Reid who actually said that she was taught that if the mother comes in with a birth plan, that she is to take it to the nurses' station and shred it, because they're on our turf now and it doesn't matter what Mom and Dad want. And, of course my chiropractor experienced this as well, because as I said he had already made arrangements, no vitamin K shot, no vaccines, they were going to give the oral form of vitamin K, and once he was in the hospital, they started talking about the state if he didn't get the vitamin K shot and next thing you know, he's saying "ok".

Janel Mirendah:

Right. This is happening every day to almost every couple that goes into a hospital in our country.

Dr. Carley:

When you think about it that they would make a birth plan with the parents. Talk about a total fraud. Basically say ok, yeah, we're going to go along with the birth plan, "yeah, we have no problem with that", and then once you get in there and you're captive, there's no more captive form of a person than being a mother in the stirrups and they've got your baby. You know, what are you going to do?

Janel Mirendah:

Or a mother with an epidural so she's numb from the waist down so she couldn't get up and protect her baby if she wanted to.

Dr. Carley:

Exactly. And there's so many traumas. The circumcision of the males is of course the most heinous. But we have the Hepatitis B vaccine, the vitamin K, shot the heel stick, and they're checking babies now for all kinds of genetic problems, although I suspect that that's actually more about getting their DNA than it is about checking to see if they have abnormal genetic abnormality. Just being in the hospital itself with all of the super bugs and being separated from the mother. In most hospitals the baby goes to the nursery, and that's the reason for the name of your DVD "The Other Side of the Glass". It was amazing seeing these fathers on the other side of the glass: they can't touch their babies, unless they are given permission at certain times, they just have to look at the baby on the other side of the glass and watch whatever is being done to that baby.

Janel Mirendah:

The name for the movie was given to me by a father in Ohio during my interviews. I was on the road for 2 years interviewing fathers and nurses and obstetricians in family practice who support a natural empowered birth. And then as I continued to interview people - without then even knowing the name of the film - because I hadn't decided the name, fathers would universally talk about "when I was on the other side of the glass." The film is touching deeply a nerve of the men in this country. People are surprised that I'm doing this film for men. They wonder, "How did, why do you do that? What does the father have to do with it?"

And, it's a tragedy actually that men are so excluded in the process and then they are so disempowered in the process itself as well. The film is about consciousness. It's about how we are a soul when we come into the sperm and the egg. We come into unity, and what's being disrupted in the medical system right now, and has been for a couple of generations, for hundreds of years actually, is really the disruption of intimacy and empathy and connection.

BREAK**Dr. Carley:**

We're back with Janel Martin-Mirendah, who is the producer of the DVD "The Other Side of the Glass", and if you could tell the listeners, Janel, how they can access this DVD, I know the final 4-hour version is still in production, but how they can access the trailer and get a glimpse of this very important work that you have done, and then we'll continue to discuss what the father should be doing. Of course, the father's job is not just to be the sperm doner. The father is supposed to protect the family, and in the hospital is the first situation in which he basically made helpless and not allowed to do much of anything. Possibly cut the cord, which they always do too early, and that's another whole subject. But the thing is, the whole idea of putting these babies behind the glass instead of letting them be in the rooms with the mothers is totally insane. If you would tell the listeners how they can watch the trailer of your very important work.

Janel Mirendah:

My web-site is www.theothersideoftheglass.com and on that site you can find the trailer, which is a 10 minute trailer, and then today, so that your listeners could have access to that draft, I've opened that up also on that page. That is the 1 hour and 50 minute draft of preview which includes the intro to the film and the closing of the film and a preview of each of the 10 chapters that will be covered in the full-length version. It's a series. It's also called *The Other Side of the Glass – a Birth Film For and About Men*.

So, it's about the male experience of giving birth, and it's not how I had planned to go, but it's been very exciting the information I've gotten from men, as I've talked to men, and men finally have a voice to talk about their experience in being in the birthing environment. Men are expected to be the protectors, and I have to admit that I started out doing this film thinking that I was going to put all the information together to give to men to be able to go in and protect their fathers (babies), like the father you described, who was probably one of the more prepared men, from what you've told me. And there are many, many couples who prepare so intently to have a

natural birth, to be drug-free, to not be harassed for drugs, to have the child in their arms, to have the cord intact.

I think that fathers have been given this really disruptive job – it's a token – to be able to cut your child's umbilical cord. What you're doing .. the father is the one who is separating, prematurely, the mother and the baby. It's very critical, critical, critical that they stay attached, and that they re-create attachment in a new way outside the womb. All of these things are going on, and he can't stop it. Men cannot stop it, and I've seen it over and over and over.

You mentioned the birth plan, and there are programs, like the Bradley Method, which includes the father, the doula. All of these things when I started out over a decade ago were showing in the research to increase the ability of the mother and the father to birth their baby in the way that they want to, and these are people who want to give birth naturally because they realize that this moment of connection is really critical to their lifetime. But what's happening is, and this has become very clear in the process of my film developing over the last 3 years, is that there's a war going on, and fathers cannot protect their child in the hospital.

That's my conclusion in the film, and when they do, fathers, men and women prepare to go to the hospital because that's "where it's safe", because that's where they have to because that's where their state laws are, that's where their insurance is, etc. When they prepare to go to the hospital, to have a natural birth, they are fighting, they are preparing to go to battle and I'm concluding that this is where our mindset for war comes from. Our culture wars on everything: the war on Christmas, the war on health care, the war on peace, the war on the war. Every time they name an issue, it's "the war on". The war on cancer, the war on poverty, the war on child abuse, it goes on and on.

I believe that when we prepare, when a couple prepares to go fight the medical system to have a peaceful, natural, empowering, even ecstatic and orgasmic birth, when we're preparing we're imprinting in our relationship, and we're imprinting in our baby this mindset of fighting for peace; warring for peace. And we see it everywhere, so what I'm actually calling for is for men - men are not going to be able to protect their wife and baby in the hospital. That's the way it is. And there are several people in my film, doctors, nurses, who will tell you about how the system works. You cannot protect your baby. So, we have to come up with some other solutions.

BREAK

Dr. Carley: We're back with What's Ailing America where our answer today is Trauma at Birth. Our guest is Janel Martin-Mirendah. We'll have Rich Winkel on the line shortly, but Janel, one of the other very important things in your DVD, and I'm so glad that you're allowing the listeners to access the hour and 50 minute version. I strongly encourage the listeners check it out and to support Janel's work. This one particular nurse, I mean, she was demonic. She was actually saying things to the baby as the baby was screaming, and they're taking the baby away from mom and they're wrapping him up so he can't move. I forget exactly what her comment to

the baby was something to the effect: "I'm in charge now". And there was also another part where it shows the mom screaming (She is not, she's crying) about them cutting the cord, she didn't want them cutting the cord. The placenta and the umbilical cord, they have all kinds of very important blood factors that the baby needs. What they always do is they cut the cord as soon as the baby is out. I can't even imagine how that was sold to the medical doctors that they should do that, but this particular mom was screaming that she did not want it done, and it didn't matter what she said, they just cut the cord.

Janel Mirendah:

The thing is is that the father was standing there and it was in their birth plan, and this doctor knew it, and even one of the nurses reminded the doctor, but what they call "delayed cord clamping" now is 3 minutes, so the language is very important. It can all be distorted to do what they want to do. One of the points I'm going to make in the full film is how this experience of this couple going in and saying, "This is what we want for our child. We've done the research and the research shows that this is what is best for our child" and then in that moment, when she is - they both are in their hormones, they both are giving birth to their child, and they are in a very vulnerable state, here are these professionals, of the medical system who actually pull her hand away and put the scissors in the father's hand and he cuts the cord.

He has severed this baby from the placenta, from his placental blood; he has severed the baby from the mother, an important connection. He has just betrayed her so deeply and he was so deeply betrayed by the medical system, and they don't have the words for it. They leave that hospital and they have to find within them the joy and the happiness of their baby and try to live life without acknowledging and without being able to address this horrendous thing that just happened them and their family.

It's a violation. It's a rape that happens all the time. They go home and try to live normally. I believe that this is why we have so many issues in our culture that are related to the health: of not getting the cord blood, of not getting your mother's breast, of not having intimacy respected, of not having empathy extended to you, compassion extended to you and to be so violated. So physically, emotionally, spiritually the acts of the medical system in that moment are very very disturbing and very disruptive to humanity. And I would go so far as to say that it is the place, the manufacturing place for the rest of the medical system.

If you can disrupt that baby, if you can take that baby's cord blood, if you can prevent them from attaching in that moment, so that breast feeding is challenging, and the mother just gives up, then you have succeeded in creating a template of dis-ease that will require some sort of intervention, spiritually, psychologically, or medically/physically, for the rest of their lives. And all these billions of dollars in services and the myriad of services, caregivers, counselors, programs, doctors -- it's all based on the symptoms, not the root cause. Not even in psychology and religion do they look at the impact of being separated from the mother prematurely; of being harshly treated - hearing violating things, lights, sound, shots. It happened to all of us, almost all

of us. The majority of humans walking on the planet today, with a few exceptions, has been violated.

So, when we start talking about it people get really upset because it's in their pre-verbal brain. The birthing brain is wiring everything that is happening. It's sensory, it's emotional, physical. It's not verbal. So the times that we lose our head, and people say, "Oh my God, she's acting like a baby," or "He's acting like a two-year-old" .. Hello, yes, that person is acting out their imprinting. We see it over and over and over, but until we acknowledge what's going on, we're going to have this huge myriad of services, drugs, surgery, counseling, therapy. It's ineffective; it's not getting us where we want to go.

Dr. Carley: Well, this is the whole basis of my work, and my first book *What Happened to the Hippocratic Oath* is almost done, and keep an eye out for it on my web-site folks, it will be on there when it's available, and I'll talk about some of my personal experiences training to become a physician. That's where I realized that they're doing these things on purpose – they're creating disease and they're creating all kinds of problems. This is the whole basis of MediSIN, and none of the things that they do work, they don't reverse anything; at best it covers the symptoms, but cause side effects. This was a very big trauma for me to have to face – that they are doing these things on purpose. Of course what you were talking about when the father was given the scissors and told to cut the cord, knowing that they had already arranged beforehand not to do that, I can't even imagine the horror of his wife watching him do that. Just like my chiropractor, who had made all these arrangements. As a matter of fact, the doctor that was supposed to take care of the birth is one of his chiropractic clients but unfortunately she wasn't on duty the day the baby was born, but he had made all of these pre-arranged plans with the doctor, and everything was supposed to be ok. Just like this father, who's given the scissors and told to cut the cord, he did all these things, and allowed all these things to be done to his new daughter, knowing they were very bad for her. It's just amazing to me, but, like you said, you're basically trapped, in the hospital under their purview, they have that CPS phone, just waiting to be called if you don't do something they want you to do. This is the reason that so many of these fathers allow these things to happen.

Janel Mirendah:

I think they allow it to happen because when they were born, this is what happened to them, and it's still that program running in our brains, and when they're in that environment, and many of them were circumcised, they are very disempowered, so they are not able to stop it. Then they have no place to talk about it. They have no place to talk about how they couldn't protect their partner. But it all goes back to an environment that is just perpetuating normative abuse.

These people that go into these professions are often good-hearted, well-intentioned people, but they're wounded people, and they're trying to find a way to heal their wounds. They want to help people, but they get into a system which just perpetuates itself, and you can't stop it. You know, anyone who is a doctor or a nurse knows that they can't stop it. How does a doctor go and do something else after he/she has invested \$200,000 in debt, and finds out, "This is brutal, I

can't do it." Well, you have to do it, but the people keep doing to other people what was done to them, and it's called normative abuse.

That's if you watch people, like the nurse, I mean this woman is brutal to this baby, just brutal, and openly brutal, and this happens all the time. I was at a birth where I supported a baby in the NICU for 2 solid days and I had to be near the regular nursery, and it was just all I could do – I had to focus on my baby, that was my baby to take care of because I saw ten to 12 babies in this nursery being mishandled, and the people watching on the other side of the glass, and they're smiling.

People are in this part of their brain where they can't even articulate it, they can't stop it even if they tried to. I have people in the film, one guy was talking about he was beating on the glass and security came to take him away, and he's saying, "Do something to that doctor"! Because they pick the baby up so roughly, they separate the mother from the baby, the baby is under lights all night long.

I saw a baby being force-fed by four women, a bottle of formula. The newborn stomach is the size of a hazelnut! The colostrum is not volume, it's a super-injection of everything the baby needs; it's not about filling the baby's stomach up. So this baby is being force-fed ounces of milk, and his stomach is the size of a hazelnut. I saw him passed from nurse to nurse to nurse. And, why is this baby not with his mother?

We need to begin to create the demand to say "You people need to be able to follow the research, you have to keep the baby and mother together. You don't separate them – it's not an option, not a choice, not a right of a woman to not be with her baby during the night. If someone chooses to have a baby, then they choose to give that baby what it needs. I happen to believe that a human baby has a right to human milk. We have abortion now, and since we have abortion a woman can make that choice, so if you choose to have a baby, you choose to give that baby what it needs. We need our culture to support that. We need funding to support the primal period, we need funding to support mothers to stay home with babies. The child care system has been known for decades to be very harmful to human beings. The research just keeps getting ignored and minimized, but it's there.

We need a maternity care package that allows, like every other industrialized nation, the United States is the only one that doesn't support of women to stay home with their children, so that you have babies in the nursery. Women going out to make \$8 an hour with subsidies by the state so that they can go to their jobs. Instead of paying a woman to take care of their own child -- she can't do that. A woman can't stay home and take care of her own child, but she pay another person to take care of her child. It's bizarre. When we start looking at ways out of this, and one of them, as Patrick was talking about – I call it "conscious conception" - where we only conceive wanted human beings who are going to be cared for, on all levels, emotionally, physically, psychologically and spiritually. That's one of the things that we can do.

But in terms of the fathers and this issue related to my film – men need to rise up. They need to see that giving birth, their child being born, is as critical as a job offer, as critical as going to get your car fixed. If you take your car, knowing it's a \$200 job, and then you come back the next day and they say, "Well, you know, we found this and that and fixed it, and now it's \$5,000 now - no, you can't do that, legally a repair place cannot do that. You have a contract.

I'm saying that men need to go to the hospital before they give birth, they need to go to the top. They need to get informed, they need to get educated on all of these things that are being done in medical systems at birth that are not scientific, and that harm the baby, the mother, and him. They need to go and they need to get a contract. They need to say: "when we come here, you are not cutting the cord, because now I know, in the research it says there is no reason to cut the cord -- even if the baby's premature". And now with a C-Section, some people where they keep the cord intact until the placenta is delivered. But it's up to the mother and the father to say that, "No, you are not giving my baby vitamin K." All that stuff has to be worked out before..

I'm proposing this ... I don't know how it will work. Go to the hospital and talk to the labor and delivery department, the OB who is in charge of the unit, the hospital administrator – go as far as you need to go. Say, "I'm going to protect my child, and you are going to do this". You can't do it when you get there. It's a war zone and you have just stepped into it, and you didn't even know it. That's what some of the fathers say. They say that you don't even know that it's happening, and then afterward, people are so numb, so overwhelmed. They have to get back to work, and they have a newborn to take care of and they just continue in this denial of how important it is.

I think that fathers who have experienced it need to rise up. If we need to we need to make legislation. Right now, ACOG, which is a club, not even scientific, they are dictating that women cannot give birth vaginally once they've had a cesareans, and doctors are creating stress and trauma in order to have cesareans. So they're creating .. the fathers in the film talk about this ... in the film, some of the father's voices are so compelling, so amazing how, the story began to be known to me by the fathers, over and over talk about the assembly line. They talked about it (birth) in terms of war and finances. And how the medical system, this is after they've been through it, the medical system, the obstetric medical system is a machine, and once you get in it, you're not in control.

We need to change legislation. Every state in this country are trying to make mid-wifery legal again. We need to make mid-wifery legal again. The physiological model of mid-wifery, not the OB-sanctioned version of mid-wifery that some people are trying to push through, but true mid-wifery. Like in other cultures, like in Belgium, The Netherlands, and in the UK, where doctors do high-risk pregnancies and deliveries, and midwives do normal births. And, probably 90% of women can give birth without a doctor present.

Dr. Carley:

Yes, here in North Carolina, it's actually illegal to have a home-birth.

Janel Mirendah:

The men need to rise up and change this, and you can't do it when you're there in the system, but for your brothers, before they give birth, and after you've been harmed, you can rise up, and you can do it for the ones coming through.

BREAK

Dr. Carley:

And we're back where our answer today is Trauma at Birth.

I want to bring Rich Winkel on now, but I want to thank you, Janel, for being on, and please stay on the line and speak up if there's something you want to comment on. As far as going to the traitors in the District of Criminals, they are the ones committing treason, and they are the ones making all of these things happen that are happening now. As I said, since the Rockefeller cartel took over mediSIN, the intention is to create disease and psychological problems, etc, etc. So there's not a chance in hell, in my opinion that they're ever going to do anything right. It's the people that have to start saying no. That's the most important word that people have to learn, in terms of everything that they're being told to do when they know it's wrong. My big thing is vaccinations of course, but there are all of these things. They have to start saying NO. And as far as making a contract, with the hospital, as that nurse, actually said, if the mother comes in with a birth plan, they take it behind the nurses station and shred it. So, I don't think that's going to work.

Janel Mirendah:

Now that's their response to people bringing it in and now people need to go beyond the nurses. They need to go to the hospital administrators, and they need to say "This is what I expect, and I'm prepared to sue you." I don't know, I'm just proposing, and exposing the whole concept for fathers, and I'm trusting that the fathers, that men, are going to be able to tell us what to do. So far, some of the response from men around the country and around the world, Israel, Dubai, I've gotten all kinds of responses from fathers, who for the first time someone is naming it for them. That's really important – I'm naming something, and it's striking, it's touching them deeply. And, I trust that *they* are going to be able to do what we know that they do – and that is to protect.

Dr. Carley:

Exactly. As far as suing, forget that, because what they will say is that the baby got standard medical care. So, forget contracts and all of these things, there are always loopholes. Patrick, did you want to say something?

Patrick Jordon:

Before we bring Rich on, Janel, you made some fantastic points. I've been taking notes throughout the entire show. Of course my position is stop breeding, but because I'm a practical

mechanist. With the histamine just in perfumes alone that induce over-sexuality, it's going to be very hard to do, so we have to ask, what's the practical alternative for "oops" babies? Now I'm not being flippant. Most of my friends, that's what they actually call their children – "oops" babies. So if we look at this from the position of Dirty Harry, who said "A man's got to know his limitations," if both the mother and the father are vulnerable going into the hospital, then just like scuba-divers that go in with a buddy system, you need somebody exactly like what you just outlined, Janel. You were there for somebody else – you were watching that baby for them. Because if they're vulnerable they're not going to be able to defend themselves, they won't be able to defend each other, and they won't be able to defend the baby.

Janel Mirendah:

And that person is vulnerable as well. When I go into that setting I (Doula) don't have any rights. It depends on the staff. The doctor in that case treated me like I was part of the team. Doulas can get treated very poorly. I think a man needs to take a man with him. I think men need to start to organize and create groups, where he can call his buddy, or there's a buddy there in the waiting room, where he's not alone, where there's 2 or 3 men.

Dr. Carley:

And we're back to "What's Ailing America?" where our answer today is "Trauma at Birth", and I would like to bring up our next guest, Rich Winkel, author of an extremely important document entitled *Male Circumcision in the USA – a Human Rights Primer*. Thanks to Rich, and this outrageous document which I encourage all of you to download and read. I have learned how bad this whole circumcision is, and it very much affected me, because I had my son circumcised.

I didn't know better at the time, and it just points out the fact that this is imprinting that's done to a male child at birth and this has so many consequences. One of my favorite quotes, which is on the front of the paper, is "What is done to children, they will do to society" Karl Meninger, M.D. So of course we know that this person in Tucson, Arizona – that looks like the riddler, who shot all those people last week - I'm sure he was circumcised, but he's probably MK-ULTRA as well.

Rich, I'd like to bring you on now. First of all if you could start by telling people how they can access this document?

Rich Winkel:

Hi Dr. Carley. All they need to do is google my name – Richard Winkel or search for the title of the paper which is "Male Circumcision in the USA – a Human Rights Primer" , or they can google my name and it will come up on the first hit.

Dr. Carley:

If you could share with the listeners – we've had you on before, but – this was such an important topic that I wanted to bring you on again with Janel, because of course, as she said, and It's self-

evident to me, that the fact that men have gone through these traumas themselves, somehow, that almost puts them into a mold where they're unable to act. And when they see the very same things happening to their male children, they do nothing to stop it, it's a self-fulfilling prophecy – it just keeps on happening.

Rich Winkel:

Yes, and I think this gets back to something you mentioned in the previous segment about the District of Traitors – the District of Criminals – the ongoing mass treason that's going on. What I'm about to say is directed specifically at the Federal agents and other Illuminati types that are listening to this show, and I know you're out there because these idiots that you're working for have an unbelievable amount of wealth to waste on things like this. I'd just like to say that if you think that you have something to gain by cooperating with these people, you don't even know what you've already lost. They have cut off your spiritual wings. They have reduced you to the status of an Egyptian slave. There's a reason that Egypt used circumcision as a mechanism of enslaving the Jews. They knew exactly what they were doing.

Dr. Carley:

Actually, that's a very important point. When we had a discussion off the air, before the show, I had asked you that, where did this whole idea come from? When you think about it. We're going to cut off the foreskin of these babies when they're born. Like who would even think of something like that? It's so demonic. So, yeah, if you could go into that a little bit as to what your research has shown – Just where did this insane idea come from in the first place?

Rich Winkel:

It came from the modern day, it dates back centuries, of course. But the people who are practicing it nowadays are essentially slaves themselves. And they are enslaved to people who have been dead for centuries. What I mean by that is circumcision is perpetuated by the psychological mechanisms of trauma re-enactment and denial. Denial is one of the stages of grief. Grief is what you go through when you realize what circumcision does, and what it's done to you and how it's affected your life.

BREAK

Dr. Carley:

And we're back to *What's Ailing America?* where our answer today is "Trauma at Birth". We have Rich Winkel on the line, author of *Male Circumcision in the USA – a Human Rights Primer*. This is a must-read for all of you, especially if you are about to give birth to a male child, so you can learn the insanity of this practice. Rich, before the break you were talking about the whole idea about how this got started. I wanted to mention that when I was in medical school, one of the ways they promoted circumcision is by teaching us that if a male is circumcised, the future wife of that male has less of a risk of getting cervical cancer. Of course, that's totally insane because, you can clean an un-circumcised penis just as well as a circumcised penis, and now that they've developed this HPV vaccine, which is actually going to cause cervical cancer. It has

very little to do with circumcision to begin with, but please continue with what you were saying, as far as how this developed in Egypt. Obviously, it's really amazing, they did this to enslave the Jewish people, and now the Jewish people are using this – I mean, they all do it. It's like a celebration – the Brith's – it's on day 8, where they all gather around the little baby and watch him scream in pain as the mo/bell cuts off his foreskin in front of the observers. It's insane.

Rich Winkel:

On the last show, the last time that I was on, I mentioned that the Jewish people brought circumcision with them when they left Egypt as a badge of belonging to their culture, in the same way that black people have appropriated the n-word as a badge of belonging and a badge of honor. It's just unfortunate that they've dragged their enslavement along with them. And now, it's pretty much infected all of this country – the United States. But getting back to the issue of enslavement, in the present day, we understand the nature of social power in a complex system like society, consisting of large numbers of individuals interacting with each other. What is the nature of power in this situation? Power is the ability of large numbers of people to act in a coordinated way. That's what power is. To sever the bond of empathy – the ability of people to relate to each other on a spiritual level where language, politics and propaganda never reach, to penetrate a person's psyche to that level you are interfering with their ability relate to other people. A Society that consists of large numbers of people of this type, is essentially a slave society, a socially atomized society where everyone is looking to the authority figures at the top of the pyramid for direction on what to do with themselves, instead of looking to their community, their neighbors, their mothers, their wives, and so on. This really is a very effective tool of social control.

Dr. Carley:

Definitely. And what the fathers are doing, in terms of just allowing the same things to be done to their little boys – listening to them scream – as this is done to them, without anesthesia, shortly after birth when the babies are older or little boys – the excuse they use to use when I was training in surgery is “Oh, this little boy has famosis – therefore we must do a circumcision – in those cases they did use anesthesia, but unfortunately, of course, after the anesthesia wears off you can only imagine the pain that must occur. I totally agree with you that this is actually leading to a lack of empathy for their own children, and they're just standing by and watching these things happen. As my own chiropractor told me he did: It was amazing, and I couldn't believe him telling me the things that he allowed to have done to his daughter after he knew they were bad and he still went along with it just because they threatened him. They mentioned that it's a state law, so he pictured CPS coming in. It's amazing.

Rich Winkel:

This shows the depth to which we as a society really are enslaved. We don't even question. We are not even capable of protecting our own children.

I can't think of a more stark illustration of what I'm talking about. Certainly, this is operative in the case of the people I mentioned before. The Federal agencies, illuminati muscle men who are

being called on to enforce this nightmare new world order that they're bringing on. These people need to understand that they have been brutalized in a way which ensures their obedience, and their fear, and their willingness to put up with this outrage on other people, because they themselves have already suffered a great deal of outrage.

Dr. Carley:

Exactly.

Patrick:

Hi Rich – This is Patrick Jordan. A list member had asked me to have you address the topic that you actually opened just now that the societal ramifications of this. My view on this is it's not unlike going to high school: as a freshman, you're beaten up so you can't wait to become a sophomore so you can start picking on underclassmen, and Janel gave us the word "normative abuse" and it seems like this is all trickle-down because people were abused, they want to enact that abuse on everybody else. Does that make sense?

Rich Winkel:

Yes, it's definitely a form of trauma re-enactment. But it's also a form of denial. Because this isn't just beating someone up. This is severing their emotional wings. You know babies are born with wings. Boys and Girls are born with...

Janel Mirendah:

This is a baby who needs to be safe: a baby who needs to be in his mother's arms, and then the bully who wants to be loved, they want to feel safe and they want to feel loved so they are acting out what happened to them.

Rich Winkel:

Right, but it goes beyond – it goes into denial, and the thing that is being denied is the loss that these little boys have suffered and the adults that they grow into, and their hopes for a decent life with a loving solid family and a strong bond with their wives and happy children – all of this stuff is terribly undermined by this practice. And you know you mentioned, Dr. Carley they were marketing this to Med students as a way of protecting women from cervical cancer, well something that it will definitely protect women from is a stable marriage. Ok, this is the highest – this country has the highest rate of divorce of any 1st world country in the world. Well, it's practically a 3rd-world country at this point, but I'm just saying - this is the elephant in the living room. This is why our families are so dysfunctional. This is one of many reasons; I mean we're under assault from many different directions. We're talking here about how you can take this power back and start to make the kind of society you've always wanted. You always wonder where these psychopaths come from. These monsters that enforce this nightmare on us. Well, they come from this re-enactment, this trauma re-enactment, this denial. They themselves have been enslaved to people who were in turn enslaved, on up the generations – we are all enslaved by people who have been dead for centuries through this repetitive process of trauma re-enactment and denial.

Dr. Carley:

Exactly. And most fathers, obviously they don't want to hurt their male children but it's amazing how many people have told me, because whenever I have a client that's pregnant and usually, now they know they're going to have a boy or a girl cuz they're doing amnios and all these things and I tell them "If I were you, I would definitely check out your document and I would certainly not get the baby boy circumcised", and so many of them say "well my husband wants it done because he wants the baby to look like him. That's a ridiculous reason. If you've been traumatized and something has been done to you – why would you want that done to your baby just so they would look like you? Also, one of the things that we've also discussed is that so many men can't face this because it is such a trauma, and even learning about what's been done to them and what the effect has been on them and so much of the hatred of men for women stems from this – obviously – like you said. I mean – this is a very big reason, very deep down, why we're having so many problems between men and women at this point. Because when the male child is circumcised, he's going to blame mom. You know they took him away from mom and they did this terrible thing to him and hurt him terribly. Deep down, engrained in him, he's going to think that mom allowed it to happen. That's going to cause a problem for him against his mom, and therefore against women. Would you agree with that?

Rich Winkel:

Absolutely! But of course it also affects the man's ability to have a spiritual, a deep emotional relationship with his wife in the future – many years in the future - this is the hurt that keeps on hurting an entire life. This is why what we're talking about is the underbelly of the beast. The issue of not wanting to cooperate with the agenda any more.

Dr. Carley: Exactly.

OK, I hear the music, we're going to a break...Stay tuned, folks, we'll be right back.

BREAK

Dr. Carley: And we're back to "What's Ailing America?" where our answer today is "Trauma at Birth", we have Rich Winkel on the line and, Rich, I just want to mention, in your outstanding document *Male Circumcision in the USA – a Human Rights Primer*, on page 4, something that we were not taught in medical school, a Dr. John Harvey Kellogg, a "well-respected" physician, and founder of the Kellogg Cereal company spoke when he wrote "A remedy for masturbation which is almost always successful in small boys is circumcision. The operation should be performed by a surgeon without anesthetic, as the pain attending the operation will have a salutary affect upon the mind, especially if you connect it with the idea of punishment". That really blew my mind that he would actually promote circumcision without anesthesia to basically tell boys that you're being punished if you've ever touched you're penis – that this is bad. And - we're going to take care of that idea by having your foreskin cut off. This is one of the many amazing things that you have documented in this document.

Rich Winkel:

It's been all downhill from there – we've become so degraded now that doctors actually masturbate infants before the circumcision in order to engorge the penis with blood so as to make the operation a little easier.

And actually, Dr. Carley, you've probably have some knowledge of this, I mean wasn't this a common practice when you were a practicing physician?

Dr. Carley:

No, I never saw that being done when I was doing surgery. As I said, the circumcision that I did when I was in training were for boys that has phimosis, so, maybe that's why they didn't masturbate them first, I don't know. If I had been told to masturbate a baby boy – that's when I would have said "*I'm getting out of here*"!! That is so bizarre.

Rich Winkel:

I was going to say someone posted a medical video – put out by a pediatric outfit in Nevada. People can locate it if they do a search for the words "neo-natal Dr. Momma video" the first you will see is a blog that will reference this video and they don't show it in the video itself, the baby getting masturbated, but they show the consequences – the erection - . because this is a common practice today: these penises are tiny – they are very small, and probably by the time a child is referred for phimosis, the penis has already grown substantially and it's not necessary to do this anymore. But for a newborn baby, this is a common practice. You can see it right here in black and white or in full color on the web if you google that phrase.

We're talking about a whole spectrum of emotional, psychological pathologies going on here, and sado-masochism is one of them. Getting back to what we're talking about here and I agree with your co-host here. This really gets to the Achilles heel of the underbelly of the beast – the core issue of why this society is going down the tubes. The mechanism by which our families are being undermined is a combination of birth abuse and circumcision.

You people out there, you're going to be stuck... There are several stages to the process of grieving. The first stage of grieving is denial. And when people find out about what circumcision involves, they go into denial just like a machine, just like clockwork, that's where they go. Most of them stay there. Most never get beyond that one. What I'm talking about – what we're talking about here is getting past the denial stage and getting to the stage of acceptance and hope and growth and empowering yourself and empowering your children to get past this insane repetition of abuse.

This is the key to the future. This is how we go from point A to point B. Right here. To stop betraying – stop this primal betrayal that leads to all the betrayal that comes later. Betraying the baby by abandoning it to the mercy of the state. This has to stop if we want to bring about a new world, a new society. We need to start loving our babies from day 1, from day 0.

Dr. Carley:

And protecting them. And not allowing these things to happen.
I totally agree with you.

Patrick:

In Dante's Inferno, the lowest section of hell called the 9th circle was reserved for treachery - to be a traitor. And you just used the word betrayer. That was very significant to me, and Norman Livergood taught about Pavlov's 2nd experiment - where the dogs were re-traumatized during a flood, and it wiped out the previous conditioning. And so it appears to me, Rich and Jenel, that if we bring these topics up - that in itself is a trauma that of course, the first is denial but how do we get past that denial. How do we use this re-traumatizing of the psyche for the benefit of getting them at least to the anger stage? Because anger actually eliminates mind-control.

Dr. Carley:

Excellent question Patrick. I'll have Rich answer it after the break.

BREAK

Dr. Carley:

And we're back to "What's Ailing America?" where our answer today is "Trauma at Birth" is our answer today, and Rich, I wanted to give you an opportunity to answer Patrick's question, but I want to also just mention that I know one of the things that they are doing with the foreskin, just to show how they've made a business out of this as well, is they sell the foreskin to drug companies and they're making 'synthetic skin' out of them to use in people that have burns and things of that nature - so there's many layers to this.

Rich:

As Patrick was talking about how do we get past the denial stage, and into the anger - I'll just go through the list here, denial, anger, bargaining, depression, acceptance, hope, growth and empowerment. Empowerment is the last stage. Empowerment is where we want to get to from denial, and it's a very difficult road, but just as Janel was talking about a woman tapping into her primal brain during birth, because her body knows what to do - men also have a primal brain, and the primal wisdom of protecting children - not just your own children, but children in general - if we can tap into that. It's right there right below the surface - the will to say no I'm not going to cooperate with this, I'm going to protect the innocent.

This is like pulling yourself up from your own bootstraps. Because once you start **to** understand who you are, then you know what your interests are. Our interests as a species, as of a civilization is to protect children. And when you tap into that power that lies below the surface, then you tap into your own road to recovery and empowerment. And there's no sweeter revenge than to put a stop to this whole insanity.

Dr. Carley:

I totally agree with you and that's why, as Patrick has been saying for years is that the most important word that people have to learn is NO. They have to educate themselves about all of these things, I mean pretty much, unfortunately, and this was a very dark night for my soul, is that everything that the medical profession is doing is against health, is against growth, is against the good of humanity.

That's why, in my opinion, of course I don't give medical advice, and I don't practice medicine, I just tell you what I would do if I was you, but I would check out everything that any white coat is telling you to do. And find out the ramifications of it and just say NO, If you find out that this is a bad thing. As far as I'm concerned, doing anything that interferes with the human body is a bad thing. They're doing all kinds of crazy stuff – biopsies for all kinds of different things, cutting out people's body parts which there came a point when I was a surgeon when I realized this is not helping people. That's what people have to do – they have to use their primal brain, their knowing that something is bad, it goes against nature and that's the amazing thing to me.

How did this whole obstetrics thing get started? In 'third-world' countries – where women give birth – they squat down, they have the baby, gravity helps deliver the baby. That makes so much sense but what do we do here? We put the woman in stirrups, we give her epidurals so she's paralyzed from the waist down and all this crazy stuff. As a matter of fact, myself, when I was delivered, they used forceps on me. I'm 56 years old and I still have a huge scar on my forehead, where this doctor put this metal clamp on my head to drag me out of my mother's uterus. I don't know if they're still using forceps now but I still bear the scar of that trauma, and these things are totally insane.

So that's why I'm so glad that I found out about your very important work and certainly people need to check this out for themselves "*Male Circumcision in the USA – a Human Rights Primer.*" Is there any work being done, Rich, as far as you know, in terms of helping males who have been circumcised deal with their own trauma? I don't know if there's such a thing as reversing a circumcision - of course, that would be furthering their trauma, in terms of having surgery, that they were able to do something to create a foreskin again and it would not replace all the things you mention in your document, that have been removed, such as the African gland In the foreskin, which produce ferimones ???

Rich:

The most important that's lost is the neurological structure of the foreskin which maps directly into the spiritual mind, into the primal mind of a man. That's what men really have a difficult time coming to terms with. But, you know, once you get past the denial stage, then you can get to the empowerment stage. We need to get past the denial, and we need to start talking to people about this, because the whole reason this has been going on for so long is because no one wants to talk about it. It's embarrassing, it's painful, there's a dozen different reasons for not talking about it, and there's only one reason for talking about it and that is to protect the future. That's the overriding concern here.

Dr. Carley:

Yes, as a matter of fact trying to get people to face this information is very similar to when I talk to parents of vaccine-damaged children. Thankfully for them, I do have a protocol that can reverse vaccine damage, but they are so not wanting to face the fact that they brought the child to the doctor who gave the shot which caused the damage.

You know there's participation here, just like when Janell was talking about that father being handed the scissors, and told to cut his baby's umbilical cord, knowing that it was the wrong thing to do, and yet he followed the orders to do that. This is so amazing, that people are just going along with the program, and that's what we're trying to empower people to do, to just say no and to check things out for yourself, and to start doing the right thing. Especially by your children. If you have children, you need to protect them and certainly circumcision is a very good place to start.

Rich:

And this illustrates the power of brainwashing. You know there are different ways of getting a population to follow orders, and the most obvious way is to lie to them about what's going on in the world, and that's the propaganda issue. A much more profound way to manipulate people is through brainwashing. This is what all this obstetrical abuse and circumcision is all about. It's about brainwashing babies to make them feel helpless, and make them obedient and good slaves.

Dr. Carley:

And it's working extremely well, unfortunately.

Rich:

Yeah, it's an illustration, like this guy knew better, he knew what the facts were, and yet still he allowed these doctors to abuse his child. That really is emblematic of the whole problem here. These Nazis that run the world – they have tapped into an ancient body of knowledge, and they're using it against us. I doubt very much if the people at the very top are circumcised. Certainly, the 1st and 2nd tier going down are probably all circumcised. Again, this is the Achilles heel of the project, because when the muscle men of the Nazis figure out how they've been treated, before they were old enough to protect themselves, they're going to realize where their real interests lie.

Dr. Carley:

Excellent point. And so, when Janel was speaking, she had suggested that people go to the hospital, to the labor and delivery area and speak to the minion in charge, and make a contract with them. Personally, I don't think that's going to work, because whether it's a birth plan that you worked out, or a contract, as I said one of the main ways these doctors get away with what they do is it's called Standard Medical Practice. This is why over 200,000 are dying every year just from pharmaceutical drugs.

You never hear of a doctor being charged with homicide except if they've killed somebody like Michael Jackson. That's a very unusual case and we'll see where that goes. As long as it's standard medical practice, it's not going to be a problem. They can always say "Oh, we didn't see the contract", or something of that nature. Or they could lose it, whatever the case may be. So what would your suggestion be to any parents who are going into the hospital? Of course I would not go into the hospital if I was them, especially if you've had a prior C-Section, you're pretty much stuck. So, do you have any suggestions for parents as to how they can protect their children once they're in that environment?

Rich Winkel:

You're being kind of fatalistic here, you're assuming that people won't be able to deal with the situation without the help of the hospital and getting back to what Janel was saying about having home births. The knowledge is out there on the internet, and while the internet is still functioning, before it's shut down, people need to avail themselves of the vast body of knowledge out there that is available to recover the ancient wisdom that has accumulated over generations of midwifery and find out how babies are born and how to do it at home. This is typical in Europe for women to have babies at home under the care of a midwife. People need to get prepared.

In Janel's film, there's one segment where a guy talks about basically being in a skirmish, a football-type skirmish in the obstetrical ward, where the doctor had the baby under his arm like a football, and he's getting ready to charge through the door that the father is blocking with his body. That's what it's going to have to come down to. It's necessary to take that baby and come in with people that you can trust and you get that baby and you protect it, and, if necessary, leave the hospital with the mother. I know this is so difficult, and this is why it's so important not to go to the hospital at all.

Dr. Carley:

I agree.

Janel Mirendah:

It's critical to look at though by doing that, by promoting that, we're promoting the mind-set of going to war to protect our child, to protect the integrity of our health, and I think that some will do that. But I think we have to have men. If one man goes to the hospital and says I want to talk to the head of OB, and say "This is what you're going to do", well that's not going to go over well. But, if multiple men come together in a community and they go and begin to outreach and they begin to demand that "my wife and I demand to have option. The research shows that home birth is safe, and in my home, my community, my hospital, we demand that we have a right to choose where we give birth, and then wherever we choose to give birth, we demand being treated with respect, to be treated kindly, and to be given our options, and to be given true informed consent." Not (skewed) consent by the doctor who wants to do the C-Section by 5:00 and get out.

We want true, informed consent and that happens when men begin to promote homebirth, natural birth, and come together. Right now it's women out there fighting for the right to give birth at home, and we need men to rise up.

Patrick:

Our listeners are no strangers to the word demand. I really appreciate you guy's viewpoint. Dr. Carley, I just want to make you aware of the time, as you have closing comments.

Dr. Carley:

Yeah, I'm going to do the closing comments during the last section. It shouldn't take me that long. I agree with you Janel, just picture if you are in an OB/GYN office, you're going to see all the moms in there who are having babies. Moms can start to give out information about this stuff and I totally agree with you – have some kind of a meeting where the dads come and make them aware of these issues. This is so important. And that is where things will change, if people go to the hospitals en masse and say “look, this is what we want, and we're not going to use your hospital if you don't do the right thing”. People have births at home all the time. Like I said, here in North Carolina it's illegal to have a home birth with a midwife.

Janel Mirendah:

That's criminal! That's criminal.

Dr. Carley:

I know it.

Janel Mirendah:

It's just criminal! And consumers need to rise up and do it (participate in addressing the hospital, and make changes) before they give birth or after they've been harmed, (they need) to go out and support other people to come together to say, “We're not going to do it.” Get in groups and go, and demand it. Go to your legislators and say, “We want a standard of care that follows the science and the research.”

You can go to any state, any community, any hospital and on every shift, any nurse and doctor will have their version of of what's scientific. The hospitals will have their protocols of what you can and cannot do, like the chiropractor experienced. It's all called “standard of care”, but there is no standard of care. You can go to a different shift, have a different nurse, and have a totally different standard of care in the same hospital. Because, she does what she wants.

Dr. Carley:

Yes, but I'm just saying, technically, they've created a standard of care, and that's what they use in courts. When doctors kill people, if the doctors have followed what they call the standard of care, which is doing whatever the different organizations, like the American Obstetrical Society or the pediatric association or any of these – they have put in their guidelines the way things should be done, and if you don't do it that way, you'll probably lose your license. So, as you

were saying that forces doctors to do things that they would probably don't do to their own family, or allow to be done to their own family.

Janel Mirendah:

They do, ironically. They believe what they're taught, and they believe the system. It's (residency training) like boot camp where they tear them down to build them up. Instead of 8 weeks, you have 3 – 5 years, and they believe it (what they are taught, rituals handed down). They will c-section their own baby. I heard a neo-natalogist high-risk specialist talking to a group of natural birthers. And, he got frustrated with all the questions about sonograms. He finally said "Hey, if I thought this was dangerous, do you think I would sonogram my child seventeen times? And this hush fell over this crowd of women, and it was like – "Well, there's nothing else to say then." This man believes that sonograming his child seventeen times because he's high-risk, and he's trained to look, that he believes that sonograms are the safest thing for his child because he's trained to look. That's how incidious it is that medical system will do to their own family members what is known in science to be traumatizing and damaging for the lifetime of the child.

Dr. Carley:

Exactly. And my answer would be "The brainwashing has been complete".

Dr. Carley:

And we're back with the last segment of *What's Ailing America* on RBN, ever. I was contacted by John Stadtmiller this past Wednesday at 2:30, telling me that this show is being pulled from RBN. He is replacing me with somebody by the name of Mary Tocco. He sent me her bio and Patrick if you're on his e-mail list he will be sending this out as an update to you, Mary Tocco has been managing and promoting a chiropractic clinic in Michigan: she is co-founder of the American Chiropractic Autism Board helping to manage hope for autism bio training conferences. Her daughter is a Defeat Autism Now (DAN) physician, and the president and co-founder of this ACAB. She's married to a chiropractor, she's not a chiropractor herself, but has attended different chiropractic seminars and things associated with vaccinations. I just want to talk about this Defeat Autism Now group, because this is something we didn't get to when we did our "Whores for Big Pharma" show. Defeat Autism Now is a total scam, it was actually started by a nutrition doctor and somebody who was investigating autism who's now dead, by the name of Bernard Gremlin. This is the guy who suggests that you give magnesium to autistic children. He started working with this PHD by the name of William Shaw. William Shaw has a laboratory where he charges thousands of dollars to do lab tests for autistic children which tell you nothing about what caused the autism, just documenting their various problems that they

have, with their nutritional ability to metabolize things, and having all kinds of abnormalities in their lab tests. It doesn't do anything with the anti-myelin antibodies, at least as far as the last documents I had. And it doesn't do anything in terms of actually showing you the cause of autism. One of the big things these DAN doctors push is chelation therapy, which of course, as we've said many times mercury does not cause autism. And also, very interestingly, Dr. Shaw previously worked for the CDC, as well as Smith Kline. All of the different therapies that I've seen from DAN doctors, and of course I've seen many because I have many clients who have gone to DAN doctors, and have actually gotten worse. They even have DAN psychiatrists now; they're giving them psychiatric drugs. But they're basically giving drugs and one of the big things that Dr. Shaw pushes is anti-fungals for the different fungal infections that these children have, because they've all been on antibiotics. He doesn't talk about why they have fungal infections, he just talks about that they have these overgrowths, and so you want to take antibiotics and anti-fungals for the problem. So, this is what the DAN doctors system is all about. There's some kind of quid pro quo there, where if you're a DAN doctor you have to refer people to Dr. Shaw's laboratory to get tests, so that's who's taking over my show folks. Isn't that amazing.
